

Lloyd House Units Close to Fully Occupied

Located on 1st Street, in the heart of downtown Menominee, Michigan we are excited to introduce an adaptive reuse of a historic building which has been transformed into 44 gorgeous apartments overlooking the shore of Green Bay, near the mouth of the Menominee River.

Almost all 44 units have been occupied. Tammy Shega, property manager, said just a few apartment units remain. "There are a number of units we are setting aside for victims of domestic abuse if they need shelters and we have some barrier frees for those who need them," she said. "If they are not rented or there is no interest shown by April 1, then I can rent them to the general population also."

Tammy Shega first saw the building when it was in near complete disrepair. "I am very touched by it. The conversations I have with the people who have applied, some of them worked there. I'm pretty wrapped up in it," she said. "Not only do I think it has evolved, I just think it's wonderful people will be living there. Wait until you see it."
